The City of Warner Robins Department of Community Development is currently preparing the Fiscal Year 2015 Annual Action Plan that details how the City proposes to use the resources during the Fiscal Year 2015 which begins July 1, 2015 - June 30, 2016.

The Plan covers the program requirements from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The Consolidated Plan describes the City's existing housing conditions and how resources will be used to address the identified needs during that five year period.

A key component in the successful development of the Annual Action Plan is the citizen participation process through which the Department of Community Development receives public input and direction on the housing and community development needs.
